

Alternate Proof of ID to Obtain a Birth Record

Applicants who do not have a valid driver's license or photo identification card, must provide a minimum of three items with their name on it. Only one of the three can be from items ordinarily stored in a wallet or purse. The list below is provided as a guide of items that are commonly used. We reserve the right to request more than three items depending on what is presented by the customer.

Expired drivers license

Expired photo ID card issued by a state

Prison ID card

Report card

Printout from social security office

Prescription bottle

Mail with your name on it -- Must be from a company or agency (not personal mail such as letters or greeting cards) (Examples of mail include: electric bill, cell phone bill, notice from court mailed to your home, bill or notice from doctor's office, correspondence from school, etc.)

Student ID card

Employment ID card

Military ID card

Diploma

Pay stub or tax forms

Items that **CANNOT** be used as alternate ID:

Court orders or other court documents

Copy of birth certificate

Copy of marriage certificate
