### **Four Charged and Sentenced in the Clio Schools Computer Hacking Case**

Flint, MI -Four people were sentenced today by 67<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge David Goggins for their role in a conspiracy to steal thousands of e-mails from the computer of Clio Schools Superintendent Fay Latture. School Board member Larry Emmerling, former City Commissioner Rebecca Freifeld, parent Julie Keyes, and teacher Diane Reed each pled guilty to conspiracy charges that carried a possible sentence of up to one year in jail. Judge Goggins sentenced each to 30 days in jail with no possibility of work release in addition to one year of probation and court costs and fines.

“I hope this brings an end to the madness in the community of Clio so that the Clio Schools can once again focus their time and energy on the education of our young people,” said Genesee County Prosecutor David Leyton after the sentencing. “We live in a society of rules and laws and those laws must be upheld for the benefit of all,” he concluded.
