**FLINT** -- Genesee County Prosecutor David Leyton has announced that he will kick-off National Crime Victims' Rights Week activities with a brief ceremony on the front steps of the Circuit Courthouse on Monday, April 23, 2007 at 12 Noon.

Prosecutor Leyton will be joined by members of his Crime Victims Services staff and other officials to commemorate the rights of crime victims and to ensure that our community never forgets or fails to honor those rights.

Prosecutor Leyton said that this year's national theme is "Victims' Rights: Every Victim, Every Time."

"Every citizen who finds themselves the victim of a crime has certain rights that are guaranteed under Michigan law. My office ensures that those rights are honored and that every victim, regardless of background or means, is given the attention and advocacy that they deserve during the judicial process," said Prosecutor Leyton.
