David Thomas of North Branch sentenced to 15-25 years for October death of Rondle Johnson of Flint

FLINT, Michigan -- A North Branch man was sentenced last week to 15 to 25 years in prison for his role in an October crash that killed a Flint man.

David M. Thomas, 35, pleaded guilty earlier this year to second-degree murder and operating under the influence, causing death.

Police said that on Oct. 20, Thomas, driving drunk at high speeds with his headlights off struck three motorists at Miller Road and Ballenger Highway as he fled from police. Killed was Rondle L. "Moon" Johnson, 47, who had recently gotten off work.
