### **Third person charged in shooting outside high school basketball game**

**January 30, 2009**

**FLINT** -- Genesee County Prosecutor David Leyton has charged a third man related to a shooting that wounded four people outside a high school basketball game last week in Mt. Morris Township.

Demario Lamar Brown, 19, of Mount Morris, was arrested earlier this week and arraigned today on five felony counts including three charges of assault with intent to murder, carrying a concealed weapon, and use of a firearm in a felony.

Investigators believe he and two other men, William Jarome Dixon, 17, of Flint, and Sammy Willie Gibbs, 18, of Flint, were involved in a January 20, 2009 shooting in a crowded parking lot outside the old Beecher High School after a boys basketball game between Beecher and Hamady high schools. Gibbs was charged with the same counts as Brown while Dixon was charged with Carrying a Concealed Weapon and as an Accessory After the Fact to a Felony, both 5-year felonies.

Police believe 25 shots were fired, hitting two Beecher students and two former Beecher students. All of the victims are expected to recover.

Preliminary exams for Dixon and Gibbs are scheduled for February 4, 2009 and Brown's preliminary exam is set for February 11, 2009.
