BRANDON HAYES TO STAND TRIAL IN BEATING DEATH OF 4-YEAR-OLD DOMINICK CALHOUN

FLINT, Michigan — Brandon Hayes, 24, was bound over to Genesee Circuit Court for trial on 10 counts stemming from the beating death of Dominick Calhoun.

Dominick, 4, was found severely beaten in the Argentine Township apartment he shared with his mother, brother and Hayes. He died the following day after he was removed from life support.

Hayes is accused of beating Dominick over several days because he was angry about money and mad that the boy wet himself and soiled the couch.

Judge John L. Conover bound Hayes over on 10 counts in the case including first-degree murder, first-degree child abuse and torture. Prosecutors today added a second child abuse charge stemming from alleged beating of Dominick's 8-year-old brother.

The Circuit Court arraignment is scheduled for July 19.
