**GENESEE (25)**

**CITY OF FENTON PROPOSAL**

**STREET IMPROVEMENTS BOND PROPOSAL**

Shall the City of Fenton, County of Genesee, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed Twenty Four Million Dollars (\$24,000,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds, in one or more series, payable in not to exceed eleven (11) years from the date of issuance of each series, for the purpose of paying the cost of acquiring and constructing street improvements throughout the City, consisting of paving, repaving, reconstructing and improving streets, including all necessary appurtenances and attachments? If approved, the estimated millage to be levied in 2022 is 3.50 mills (\$3.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds is 3.03 mills (\$3.03 per \$1,000 of taxable value).

**CLAYTON TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL**

**POLICE MILLAGE**

Shall the Charter Township of Clayton levy up to 2.9 mills against the taxable property within the Charter Township of Clayton commencing on December 1, 2021, for a period of 5 years raising up to an estimated \$682,569 in the first year the millage is levied? The purpose of this levy is to provide funding for the operation of the Charter Township of Clayton Police Department.

This millage replaces the 1.9 mills millage that expired in 2020 and the 1.0 mills millage that expires in 2021 for a total of up to 2.9 mills for the operation of the Clayton Township Police Department.

**MONTROSE TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL**

**MOSQUITO ABATEMENT PROGRAM ASSESSMENT**

Shall Montrose Charter Township impose a Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollar assessment upon each real parcel within the Township and each lot within a registered Mobile/Manufactured Home Community within the Township for a period of ten (10) years, 2022 through 2031 inclusive, to provide funding for a Township wide mosquito abatement program, thereby raising an estimated \$75,525 in the first year the assessment is levied.

**MUNDY TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL**

**MOSQUITO ABATEMENT SPECIAL ASSESSMENT**

This special assessment for all parcels of land within the Charter Township of Mundy is for mosquito abatement, as allowed by law.

Shall the Charter Township of Mundy impose a Twenty-Eight Dollar and 73/100 (\$28.73) assessment upon each real parcel within the Township and each lot within a registered mobile/manufactured home community within the Township for a period of five (5) years, 2022 through 2027, inclusive, to provide funding for a Township wide mosquito abatement program, thereby raising an estimated Two Hundred Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$207,833) each year of the assessment?

**GOODRICH AREA SCHOOLS PROPOSAL**

**OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL**

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2022 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 20.128 mills (\$20.128 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Goodrich Area Schools, Genesee, Oakland and Lapeer Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2023 to 2027, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2023 is approximately \$1,500,000 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2022 tax levy)?
