WELCOME TO GENESEE COUNTY!

DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHT: GIS

A GIS (Geographic Information System) is a computerized database built on the foundation of a digital map. The Genesee County GIS Department promotes and supports the use of this technology across departmental and jurisdictional boundaries. The core data of our system consists of aerial imagery and property parcels with many other map data layers complementing these. This information is made available internally through our Pictometry viewer. Much of the same information is also available to the general public through the online system called FetchGIS.

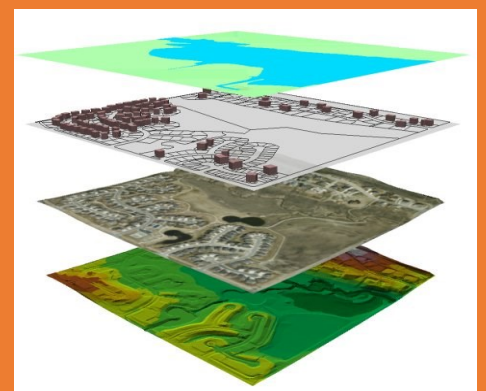
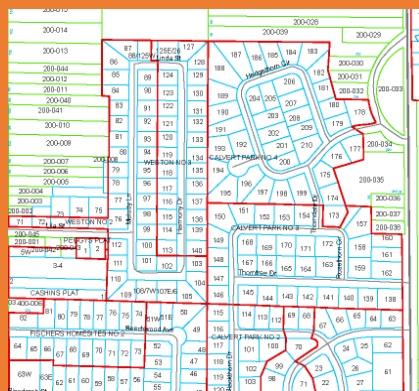
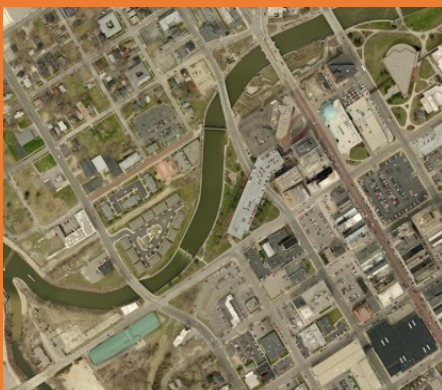
To access FetchGIS go to: App.FetchGIS.com/Genesee

Through the online GIS, the public can easily search for property parcels and view hi-resolution aerial images from four different years. They can also view streets, elevation data, soils, wetlands, flood zones, zoning and other map data layers.

The GIS department can make custom maps printed from letter size through 32x48 inches, create custom data layers for departments, and assist in the use of the mapping technology in many different ways.

Genesee County GIS Department:

- Supports the use of Pictometry for over 400 users across 32 partner entities.
- Has created a county-wide hydrant layer for 911 with over 15 thousand hydrants.
- Has created a set of contours maps of the bottom of 12 public access lakes for the Sheriff's Department Dive Team
- Provides GIS data to support school bus routing.
- Updates and maintains maps of voting precincts.
